The resident died.</p> <p>Failure to suction tracheotomy tube to prevent blockages; falsifying documentation; failure to perform CPR on a resident who was not breathing. Gratiot Co.; Ashley	Ashley Care Center	A staff member was caught stealing medication and pain patches from residents.	The facility was cited for this.
St. Joseph Co; Three Rivers	Heartland Health Care Center, Three Rivers	A resident was given medication without a doctor's order and experienced a fall as a result of being groggy. The fall resulted in a hip fracture which directly contributed to the resident's death.	1 RN
